INTRODUCTION



As a former high school teacher who arrived at school at 7 a.m. to tutor a new student, left school after 5 p.m. and still had hours of correcting papers ahead of me, I knew I had to change direction. I had no life! After four years, I left teaching, was hired by IBM as an instructor at double the salary and half the hours. Years later I developed my own programs and taught from home.

Now is your opportunity to program your GPS. What is your "why" - your purpose? Where do you want to go? 1) Back to the classroom? 2) Your own training business? (There are 3.72 million school-age (K-12) homeschool students and 49.7 million public school students.) 3) Corporate training/design?

Although there are some spontaneous, free-spirited people who might like the excitement and unpredictability of an unplanned trip, most wouldn't leave home without a destination in mind, or without directions to get them from Point A to Point B. Using this as a metaphor for teachers who want change, not knowing exactly where you're going or how to get there isn't a good way to make a decision.

I created this "roadmap" because so many teachers are struggling to find the job that utilizes their strengths and talents, that makes getting up in the morning exciting, and that provides them with a considerably larger salary.

How great would it be to feel excited when you awaken every morning? Wouldn't it be nice if you could do what you wanted to do every day and still earn money? Wouldn't everyone like to feel that what they do makes a difference in the world?

All of this is possible once you know what your purpose is in life. Author, Barbara Sher, said it best in the title of her book, I Would Do What I Love If Only I Knew What It Was.

Everyone has unique talents, knowledge, skills, and abilities. Finding which skill, which bit of knowledge, or which talent you most enjoy using will lead to discovering your purpose.

Wayne Dyer wrote, "There is no scarcity of opportunity to make a living at what you love; there's only a scarcity of resolve to make it happen." Even Oprah said, "Your job is to discover what your true calling is. Therein lies your happiness."

Step one on your roadmap is to find your specific talent or interest through a course and coaching program so you can earn money doing what you love. COURSE: 5 Steps to Clarify Your Purpose

- **1.Your Story Analysis:** Your life story is an important aspect of your identity and helps shape how you see yourself and the world around you. It is a unique record of your experiences, challenges, and growth. By reflecting on your life story, you can gain a deeper understanding of your values, beliefs, and motivations, and identify patterns and themes that have shaped who you are today. Taking the time to understand and reflect on your life story can also help you set meaningful goals for the future and make positive changes in your life. Overall, your life story is a valuable tool for personal growth, connection, and self-discovery.
- 2. Train Your Brain: Training your brain is the process of becoming more mindful of your thoughts and developing the ability to control them. It involves recognizing negative or unproductive thoughts and consciously replacing them with positive and empowering ones. This can help reduce stress, anxiety, and negative emotions, while increasing feelings of happiness and well-being. Training your thoughts also involves focusing on the present moment and developing a growth mindset. - **3. Habits:** Habits are powerful tools for shaping your life and reaching your goals. They are automatic and repetitive behaviors that we engage in regularly, often without conscious thought. They include Communication skills, verbal and non-verbal; Listening Skills, the least taught form of communication; Attitude skills related to the pause between stimulus and response; and People Skills, especially those promoted by Dale Carnegie in *How to Win Friends & Influence People.*



If you choose to start your own training business, the primary question you need to ask is, "How can an educator best equip a child to succeed and be happy in today's society?" "How can a teacher instill self-belief in a student?"

Answer: Provide courses that will provide the following:

- 1) the **EXPERIENCE of acceptance and validation from peers** whether it be from their friends or a totally different groups of kids. Inherent in positive interactions is KINDNESS!
- 2) the **EXPERIENCE** that will enable each student to learn the basics of communication skills—verbal and non-verbal, listening skills, attitude training, and people skills, and
- 3) the OPPORTUNITY to learn their "purpose" through discovering their specialness, and
- 4) to have fun!

Everyone lives their lives from their own individual framework, a set of guiding principles they may not even be consciously aware of. These principles are formed from childhood experiences, family interactions, schooling, friendships, religious and ethnic training.

We have to ask ourselves: What is my personal role in the world? How great is my human compassion? Is the phrase "Peace on earth; good will to all" merely a saying or is there meaning within those words? Catherine of Siena said, "Proclaim the truth and do not be silent through fear."

Belief in justice, equality, peace, and community is a strong, solid common ground on which to start. The students make the choices; the students decide on their own value systems. The commonality among all choices must include kindness.

To be made invisible is to be made impotent. Marginalization can be worse than death.

Through actual interaction with others in the classroom or via zoom, **students experience acceptance by their peers** in situations where they never would have been able to get to know one another. The nerds, the brainiacs, the sport heroes, the tough guys, the potential dropouts, rich and poor get to experience first-hand, their own specialness from their peers. How great is that!

With acceptance, validation, and kindness, what their minds can conceive and believe, they will be able to achieve!
